
Kidubar Information and Instructions

TERMS OF USE:

- a) All sports equipment inherently has risk associated with use. The kidUbar is no different and there is an onus on the parent, guardian or any other person, using the kidUbar with a child on the bicycle connected to the kidUbar, to act with care and responsibility. The kidUbar should be used within the normal range of activities considered for a small child's bicycle, with special consideration to terrain, traffic, other persons and environment, as examples.
- b) The **kidUbar** should be connected to a bicycle it is designed to fit being a child's 14" with handlebar style and measurements as shown in the Step 1 handlebar diagram below.


Technically the kidUbar optimally designed to fit a child's 14" bicycle with measurements as indicated the above diagram and as per the below specifications:

(i) Handlebars are mountain bicycle style and not childrens' bull horn style.

- (ii) Measurement of the handlebars from grip end to grip end should be between 52cm 58cm.
- (lii) Measurement horizontally from the stem of the bicycle handlebars to the furthest point of the rear wheel should be 72cm to 74cm.


HOW TO INSTALL AND ATTACH:

Step 1: Inserting handlebar connectors into the bicycle



- HANDLEBAR CONNECTOR
- Using a sharp cutting tool (such as a Stanley knife) cut out both ends of the handlebar grips exposing the inside of the handlebar.
- Insert the handlebar connector fully into the now open ends of the handlebar.
- Holding Part A tighten the handlebar connector into the handlebars by turning Part B.
- Ensure the handlebar connector is firmly secured inside the handlebar.
- Once inserted into both ends of the handlebars, the handlebar connectors are not removed.

Step 2: Attaching the kidubar to the bicycle



- The **kidubar** can now be attached to the bicycle handlebars for use.
- Attach the pieces (Part D) to assemble the kidubar as shown in Fig.1, securing with the provided hand bolts (Fig.1 - Part C)

- In attaching Part D ensure Part E correctly faces inward to allow screwing into the handlebars.
- Attach the **kidubar** (Fig.1) into the handlebars (Fig.2), by inserting and screwing the hand knob bolts (Fig.2 Part D).
- Ensure Part E is securely tightened.
- To remove the kidubar from the bicycle simply unscrew Part E.
